NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY

The Fairview Independent School District offers the following vocational educational programs for all students regardless of race, color, national origin, including those with limited English proficiency, sex or disability in grades 9-12: Advertising/Promotion, Principles of Teaching, Principles of Marketing, and Digital Literacy. The following vocational school classes are available to students in grades 11-12: Heating/Humidification; Cooling/Dehumidification; Refrigeration Fundamentals; Journeyman Preparation; Introduction to Computer aided Drafting; Basic Welding; Shielded Metal Arc Welding; Gas Metal Arc Welding; Oxy Fuel Systems; Construction I and II; Introduction to Architecture; CAD 100 Introduction to CAD; CAD 102 Drafting Fundamentals; Print Reading; and Medical Terminology.
