GRADING PROCEDURES for FAMILIES
COVID-19 Emergency Closure
 4/24/2020

Students completed the first three nine weeks of the 19/20 School Year prior to the emergency closure starting on March 16, 2020.

Students are required to complete all student work assigned during the emergency closure and the work is expected to be submitted on the due date outlined in the Emergency NTI Closure Plan.

Students are given one week after the last day of the assigned work before it is due.

Students will receive a grade on their NTI assignments during the emergency closure. This will be reflected on their report card for the 4th Nine Weeks.

Grading will be based on the student's completion of the work and submission time and broken up by each two week time period as follows:

A Student's 4th Nine Weeks Grade will be determined based on the student's completion and submission of work by due date as follows:

If ALL work IS completed and submitted for the closure period on time, the student will not receive an overall grade for the 4th Nine Weeks lower than the average of their grade for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Nine Weeks. If the student completes and submits all NTI assignments on time, the student's performance on NTI assignments will not lower a student's grade, however it may improve a student's grade.

If ALL work is NOT completed and submitted for the closure period, the student will receive a zero on assignments not completed and submitted. Students may receive an overall grade for the 4th Nine Weeks lower than the average of their grade for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Nine Weeks since they did not complete and submit their work.

If ALL work IS completed and submitted for the closure period but the work is submitted late, the student may receive an overall grade for the 4th Nine Weeks lower than the average of their grade for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Nine Weeks, but the overall grade for the 4th Nine Weeks will not be more than 12 percentage points lower than the average of the first three nine weeks. See the chart above for calculations.

If ALL work is NOT completed and submitted for the closure period and the work is submitted late, the student will receive a zero on assignments not completed and submitted. Students may receive an overall grade for the 4th Nine Weeks lower than the average of their grade for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Nine Weeks since they did not complete and submit their work. This grade will be lowered up to an additional 12 percentage points based on the information included in the chart above.

Additional Grading Details

In middle and high school classes that are only semester classes and not year-long classes, only the 3^d Nine weeks grade will be used as there are not multiple nine week grades to average.

It is at the teacher's discretion to make a determination of the student's completion of work. If there is evidence of minimal effort based on the teacher's knowledge and understanding of the individual student, a teacher may determine the work is incomplete and apply this in grading. Likewise, if a student skipped over a question or missed a page or part of an assignment, the teacher may give the student credit for completing all work based on their knowledge and understanding of the individual student.

In certain situations, teachers have given extended time to students. If extended time has been given, the student's grade will not be impacted by late submission.

Due to the safe and healthy of students, students will receive their work back with teacher feedback when they return to school next year

Report Cards

Students will receive report cards in the mail before June 26, 2020. The 4th Nine Weeks will include three entries in Infinite Campus with one grade being entered for each of the three extended closure periods outlined above.
