This applies unless your child's teacher has discussed with you another option due to their specific content (this is very few students).</p> <p>NTI Days 21-30 Assignments for Pre-K through 11th Grade will be one project (Project #1) and the start of a second project (Project #2). ADDITIONAL NOTES

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Additional at home instruction days for the remainder of the year have not been determined at this time. As of April 3, 2020, we are scheduled to return **5/4/20**. **IF** we do not return to school this year, students will have the assigned work at home since it will be disseminated with the work going out for NTI Days 21-30. See explanation above.

From this date forward, collection will occur on the dates listed above in the drive-thru on the cafeteria side of FMS/FHS. Parents and families are asked to put their child's completed work in the boxes made available. Parents are asked to wait in their vehicle until the person ahead of them exits and gets back in their vehicle. A staff member will be inside the cafeteria to monitor but will not be accessible to parents and families. WIFI is available in the parking lots of both schools for students in grades 3-12 to access on their chrome books while in a vehicle. Individuals on district property are not authorized to exit their vehicles while present to use the WIFI services.
