

COVID 19 School Closure
Student Feeding Plan

The Fairview Independent School District will be serving FREE breakfast and lunch to all school-aged students during the school closure starting Tuesday, March 17, 2020. Participation is NOT based on income. All families are encouraged to participate and not see this as an income-based support. Due to federal funding we applied for yesterday and just approved today, we will receive reimbursement based on the number of meals served. This reimbursement supports our efforts with this work so it is important that you know that your participation is not an added expense on our district.

The student does not have to be present when handing out breakfast and lunch.

Students receiving breakfast or lunch during the school closure may do so through one of the two following options:

- 1) Breakfast and Lunch drive-thru set up at FMS/FHS – Someone will be outside to assist with lineup the first few days. ALL MEALS WILL BE SERVED OUT OF FMS/FHS ONLY.
- 2) Lunch delivery ONLY to Fairview Independent School District students residing in the Westwood Community. We cannot deliver outside of the Westwood Community, however school-aged students, regardless of their enrollment at Fairview, are eligible for FREE breakfast and lunch through the drive-thru.

Breakfast and Lunch Pick-up from 11:30-12:30

Drive-thru Service

Students who are participating in breakfast or lunch drive-thru do not need to do anything in advance to enroll and should simply arrive at the cafeteria side of FMS/FHS and enter the drive-thru during the times outlined above.

Delivery Service

Breakfast and Lunch will be delivered to homes between the hours of 12:00-1:00 on Tuesday and Friday ONLY. On Tuesday, three breakfast meals and three lunch meals will be delivered. On Friday, four breakfast meals and four lunch meals will be delivered. It is important to watch for the delivery during these times.

Students or parents/families who are participating in delivery for students will need to be ready to come out and get their lunch when the bus arrives with the same time expectations that are in place when they ride the bus in the mornings. The bus cannot wait longer than a few seconds for the students to come out.

On Tuesday, staff will follow every transportation route and stop at locations on the bus route just as they would be picking up students for school. On Tuesday and Friday, staff will only stop at locations on the bus route if the student participated in previous weeks.

To be added back to the list or to be added to the list on specific days only, please call the central office at [606-324-3877](tel:606-324-3877) between [11:00 – 12:00 on Tuesday or Friday](#) and ask to speak with Mrs. Terri Hood or Mrs. LeighAnn Jobe and added to the lunch delivery list for that day. The call must be made between [11:00-12:00 on Tuesday or Friday](#) the day of the requested delivery if the student has not been participating in delivery of lunch. **It is not necessary to call and be added to the list if the student has been participating.**

Students who attend the Fairview Independent School District but do not ride the bus, may participate in lunch delivery during the school closure but will need to call and request to be added to the list.
